Gifts pending acknowledgment shall be accepted as received by the Superintendent, at his or her discretion, with a list of gifts of \$5,000 or more being presented to the Board on a quarterly basis.

Frost Elementary PTO donated \$38,102.50 to Frost Elementary School for technology devices for classrooms.

Frost Elementary PTO donated \$9,525 to Frost Elementary School for an outdoor learning area surface.

Runze Ye and Ying Ying Bao donated \$5,000.00 to Randle Elementary School for field trips.

Frost Elementary PTO donated \$10,636.20 to Frost Elementary School for books for the literacy library.

Parents of Briscoe (POB) donated \$9,625.00 to Briscoe Junior High School for theatre curtains.

Texas A&M University donated \$6,750.00 to Foster High School for the 2025 Power-Up Program invoice.

Fidelity Charitable donated \$6,000.00 to Leaman Junior High School for the Theatre Department.
