



# How to Get Your Child Vaccinated for COVID-19

**Be Ready, Minnesota. Kids Deserve A Shot.**

Children ages 5-11 are eligible to receive the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine for 5-11-year olds.



## 3 Ways to Get Your Child Vaccinated

1. Visit [mn.gov/vaxforkids](https://mn.gov/vaxforkids) to find and contact providers or pharmacies near you, including:
  - o Pediatric and family medicine clinics, primary care providers, federally qualified health centers, local public health agencies, tribal health agencies, state community sites and clinics, and Indian Health Service locations.
2. Check with your pediatrician or family medicine clinic about appointments.
3. Watch for vaccination clinics being offered at schools or other community locations around Minnesota.

### THE FACTS

- The vaccine is safe for children ages 5-11.
- The vaccine protects children and families from COVID-19.
- The vaccine is free.

Children ages 5-11 who complete a COVID vaccine series in January or February are eligible to receive a \$200 Visa gift card and enter a drawing for five \$100,000 college scholarships.
