Attached for the President and Board of Regents consideration and review is the 2025 certified ad valorem anticipated collection rate and the certified excess debt collections.

This Tax Assessor/Collector certification is required by the State Property Code, Section 26.04(b) and must be submitted to the governing body and used in the Truth in Taxation 2024 debt service calculations which are done for the certified estimates/certified appraisal rolls.

The anticipated combined debt service collections of the current and delinquent taxes with penalties, interest, and miscellaneous revenue will provide Lee College 98.00% collections for the 2025 tax year. The 2024 debt service tax collections will not have any excess debt collection certified.


CERTIFICATION OF ANTICIPATED COLLECTION RATE FOR
