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DYSLEXIA in the FIE (Full and Individual Evaluation)

Diagnostician met with individual campuses to address students with reading difficulties and concerns. The students will be addressed for possible Dyslexia and/or Learning Disabilities in reading through an FIE. As per the law firm Walsh and Gonzalez, it is in the districts best interest, although not mandated by law to include this evaluation in the FIE and as a possible part of the SPED eligibility process.

VISIT/TOUR of AUTISM SPECIALIST CLASSROOM

SPED teachers observed a teacher with multiple students with varied levels of autism. They were able to gain valuable tools and methodologies to implement in the classroom for students with varied levels and demands of autism.
