Amphi Foundation Grant Proposal



General purpose of the project:

Provide an objective and the numose of the project

We would like to have students use heart rate monitors once a week to track heart rate when exercising. The purpose of this project is to have students correlate the rate of exertion and physical fitness level with heart rate. The overall goal is to have students understand the importance of increasing heart rate during exercise and how it affects their physical fitness level.

Describe the project and how it will enhance the learning environment and promote academic excellence.

List the subject areas involved in the project.

Project Synopsis:

Physical Education Classes: basketball, aerobics, sports conditioning, weight training, volleyball and team sports. Students will wear a heart rate monitor during fitness testing. They will log heart rates before, during and after a 5 minute recovery. Students will hopefully be motivated to keep improving their heart rate by giving maximum effort in class.

Provide the standards of measurement to be used to determine if goal(s) have been achieved and timeline for assessment of results. If applicable, explain how the project will be sustained without committing district funds.

Evaluation and Sustainability plan: Students will be assessed during a physical fitness test (i.e. mile run, jump rope, bleachers etc.) once a week and will record heart rates before, during and after recovery. Students will comprehend that the lower the heart rate during exercise and the faster the recovery heart rate equals a better overall level of fitness. We will begin testing in as soon as we receive the monitors and will continue to test until May 2019. We can sustain this yearly, by testing in different types of exercises (i.e. anaerobic vs. aerobic, resistance training vs. endurance training, etc.). We would not need any further funds from the district after the initial cost of monitors.
