SUBJECT: Business Professionals of America – Overnight Trip Request

Background and Findings:

High School Teacher Patricia Lōser is requesting permission to take four Belding High School students on an overnight field trip to the Business Professionals of America National Conference May 6-11, 2025, at the Gaylord Palms Resort and Convention Center in Kissimmee, FL. The students will compete in various events that test their business skills and participate as Michigan voting delegates at the conference, as well as attend several “Leadership Passport Workshops” which are workshops to improve business skills. A copy of the proposed itinerary has been forwarded to the Board.

Other Considerations:

It is part of BPA requirements that all Michigan delegates stay overnight at the Gaylord Palms (location of the conference) for the duration of the event. Funding is partially provided through the current BPA Club fundraising account, various donors, and student-led fundraising efforts. Patricia Loser will be the advisor chaperoning this trip.
