Purpose of Report

The purpose of this workshop is to request the Board of Trustees to review calendar options considered by the Superintendent's Cabinet. A recommendation to the Superintendent regarding the 2011-2012 school calendar is forthcoming.

Objectives

The board will review one calendar option, which is based on the following guidelines:

- 180 days of student instruction, three (3) Staff Development waiver days included
- Seven teacher in-service days—teacher contract 187 days
- According to Education Code 9.01-9.04 amended by the 79th legislature, school may not start before the fourth week of August, being August 23rd.
- Two bad weather days must be built in.
- Holidays:
 - 1. Labor Day
 - 2. Thanksgiving holiday
 - 3. Winter (Christmas) holiday
 - 4. Martin Luther King Day
 - 5. Spring break
 - 6. Memorial Day

Operational Impact

Option 3 has a start date of August 22nd. The last day of school would be May 31st.

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<u>Results</u>

Approval of the calendar will allow instructional staff to confirm dates for in-service, testing and planning activities for staff development.
