

Use of Denton ISD Facilities for November General Election

Facility Usage

- Election Code 43.031 (c) The building selected for a polling place shall be a public building if practicable. The entity that owns or controls a public building shall make the building available for use as a polling place in any election that covers territory in which the building is located.

Future Election Dates

- November Uniform Elections
 - Held the Tuesday following the first Monday of the month.
 - November 8, 2022
 - November 7, 2023*
- Primary Elections
 - Held in even-numbered years, usually on a Tuesday with runoffs also held on a Tuesday.
 - March 5, 2024*
- May Uniform Elections
 - Held the first Saturday in May with runoffs also held on a Saturday.
 - May 6, 2023
 - May 4, 2024*

** These dates are subject to change pending the 2023 legislative session*

Process With County

- County requests election sites
- For November 8, 2022, county requested 17 sites (14 student campuses and 3 administrative sites without students)
- Worked with County to consider other sites within precinct that did not have students - (Tuesday) election
- Found one church
- Final count – 13 student campuses and 3 administrative sites without students
