Subject: Replace the chilled water Bladder Tank and insulation around the area at the Science Building on the Wharton Campus.

Recommendation: Accept the quote from MLN Service Company, and AAR Incorporated to remove and replace the chilled water Bladder Tank and insulation in the Science Building for \$21,370.63 with funds taken from the Plant Repair and Replacement Fund.

Background and Rationale: The Bladder Tank at the Science Building was installed at a time when it was common to use an asbestos insulating material to keep the water chilled. That's why there are 2 companies listed to complete the project. MLN to replace the Bladder (\$15,590.00), and AAR Incorporated to do the asbestos abatement in the area so that the replacement bladder can be installed (\$5,780.63). The replacement bladder is being purchased using a Texas Buyboard Cooperative Contract # 720-23. This work would be completed using money transferred from the Plant Repair and Replacement Fund.
