

Gymnasium Bleacher Replacement

Re: Gymnasium Bleacher Replacement RFP

As part of the Phase One bond projects, gymnasium bleachers are to be replaced at CMS East, Pinkerton Elementary, and Lee Elementary in June of 2007. Proposals meeting the specifications were received from two highly qualified, reputable bleacher companies, Specialty Supply & Installation, LLC (specializing in Hussey brand bleachers), and the John F. Clark Company (specializing in Interkal brand bleachers). We currently utilize both of these brands of bleachers throughout the school district. More specifically, the proposals received are "turn-key" including all labor and materials for the removal and replacement of the complete bleacher systems at each school.

The bleacher replacements will have essentially the same configuration as the existing systems, except will be fully ADA and code compliant.

The Request for Proposal Method (RFP) as provided in the Texas Education Code 44.031 was used to obtain proposals.

Of the two proposals submitted, the John F. Clark Company provided the proposal with the best value for the district. Their total proposal of \$88,275 was \$10,416 less than Specialty Supplies bid of \$98,691. \$142,000 was budgeted for these three bleacher projects.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Coppel ISD Board of Trustees approve the John F. Clark Company as the contractor to complete the gymnasium bleacher replacements at CMS East, Pinkerton Elementary, and Lee Elementary as specified in the Request for Proposal for the sum of \$88, 275.
