Item Name: CONSIDER APPROVAL OF RATIFICATION OF DONATIONS TO THE DISTRICT

- Frost PTO donated \$5,557.50 to Frost Elementary School for Raz Plug for Kindergarten 2<sup>nd</sup> grade.
- McNeill PTO donated \$10,367.24 to McNeill Elementary School.
- Texas A&M Engineering donated \$13,500.00 to Lamar Consolidated High School for the Workforce Industry Training (WIT) program.
