We had to take a district vehicle to Northern Ford in Cutbank and get the suspension system fixed they did repair and it is now running again.

Our plows were out sanding and plowing the roads around the schools to help cut back on some of the snow accumulations and ice buildup.

For December we had 26 incidents on the bus and 7 removals. Having the few riders we did get helped cut back on some of the behavior problems on a couple of the buses.
