Project Success was first used with gifted & talented children, including a Native American population. PSE employs program flexibility allowing **multilevel cross-curriculum activities** to be differentiated for students of all abilities. Project Success has been adopted at Browning Elementary as their writing program. The goal at BES is to **integrate** Science, Social Studies & literature through the Wonders program, using Project Success formats. The anticipated scope & sequence for 2022-2023 will be developed on June 6, 2022.

Project Success Enrichment has been invited to the SBE session on Monday afternoon to facilitate and create the scope & sequence. Mrs. Colleen Wilson is a regional trainer for PSE and will be in attendance as a consultant.

PSE teaches reading, writing and thinking through active and **sequential activities** that will be immediately applicable in classrooms. The language skills are taught in a **simple-to-complex** sequence that promotes cooperative learning, creativity, questioning strategies and academic vocabulary. We will begin with **vocabulary development**, then using those strategies, the sequence moves into **sentence fluency** developing grammar and conventions. Finally, after strategies are stronger, **paragraph development** will wrap up the scope & sequence for first semester.
