
Happy First Week of Class!!

Fall First-Day Enrollments

First-day headcount enrollment for Fall 2023 is **5,741 students**. This total is approximately **4% higher** than the first-day enrollments for Fall 2022 and **3% higher** lower than Fall 2021!! In addition, students are registered for **56,654 credit hours**, which translates to a **5% increase over last year**!

Students may still register for 16-week classes through Tuesday, August 29, and for 14-week sections through Monday, September 11.

Friday, September 8: Our Pioneer baseball team heads to the coast for their season opener against Galveston College!


Friday, September 22: Saddle up in support of our Cowboys' and Cowgirls' first rodeo of the year at Panola College!

Strategic Plan Key Performance Indicators

With the recent passage of House Bill 8, the majority of funding for Texas Community Colleges will now be based primarily on performance outcomes, specifically metrics such as the number of licensures or certifications awarded, number of graduates, and number of transfer students.

The WCJC Strategic Plan includes multiple key performance indicators (KPIs) that allow for us to holistically evaluate student achievement, including persistence, graduation, and transfer rates. The AY 2023 Annual Report for the Strategic Plan will be published in September 2023 and will include progress reports for each goal, as well as updated data for all KPIs.




Persistence, Graduation, and Transfer Rates.








Tech Tools to Make Your Life Easier!
