

1. Handbook Changes:

Changed: Public Act 97-0742 School Districts/Regional Office of Education/Intermediate Service Centers-5 hours of instruction on First and Last day of School (effective June 30, 2013)

To: Public Act 101-0012 School Districts/Regional Offices of Education/Intermediate Service Centers- Reinstates Minimum 5 hours of Instruction on Regular Attendance Days. Effective June 5, 2019

p. 12- removed notation concerning face masks on the bus.

p. 14- Breakfast Program: Students will be eating breakfast in the cafeteria, not in the classrooms.

p. 14-Lunchroom Behavior: 14. Social distance requirement removed.

p. 15 Dismissal and Arrival Procedures: Parents are reminded that they are not to use the back parking lot for arrival or at dismissal time due to the high traffic from busses and staff.

p. 15- Dismissal and Arrival Procedures: 15. Parents are reminded that students use the front doors and all adults are to use the buzzer in the back. Adults are not permitted in the building without an escort from the Administrator.

p. 16/17- Moved the Communicable disease section to follow the Health Services section & removed the Covid rules.

Adjusted the Attendance & Truancy section to reflect changes and standardization across the district as suggested by the RAP program.
