Child Care -

The Child and Adult Care Food Program annual application update has been completed and awaiting approval. The Stars for Quality application needed to be updated by April 1st. As a center we are unable to continue being a Stars to Quality program due to having so many staff turnovers within the school year.

We have welcomed three new staff members within the past month. The children are adjusting well to Nado MadPlume in the infant/toddler room, Bristen Belcourt, part time and Monica Rider, part time. All three staff members have jumped right into the position and the children are adjusting well to some of the changes.

The toddlers are actively working on some of the end of the year developmental goals. Some of these goals include writing their name, identifying at least 5 shapes, colors, numbers and letters. Ms. Brittany Burns has been bringing the 3 year olds to the BES library weekly and they enjoy the opportunity to participate in literacy activities and checking out books for their classroom.

The infant room attendance has been very sporadic all year long and this makes it very hard for the teachers to consistently work with the children on some of their developmental goals. However, the environment remains stable, friendly, caring and responsive to the social and emotional needs of each child. We are seeing growth in the behaviors of each child that attends.
