- 1. Title I and State Compensatory Education** –Currently we have 238 students who qualified for this program. This number drives our funding for Title 1 and SCE.
- 2. Discipline** – We had one HS students assigned to DAEP for 10 successful days. His assignment began on March 17th. This student's last day in DAEP was April 2nd.
- 3. TELPAS** – During the month of March, all ESL students were tested for TELPAS (includes speaking, listening, reading and writing).
- 4. Region 16 Assessment Conference** – on March 6th, I attended the morning session of the Region 16 Assessment conference. Then assisted with Bobcat Relays that afternoon.
- 5. WTAMU Job Fair** – Mr. Thompson and I attended the Education job fair on March 25th, we met with lots of senior and a few juniors interested in teaching.
- 6. STAAR/EOC testing** – March 30th, 31st and April 1st – our first round of state assessment – 4th and 7th grade writing; ELA I, 5th and 8th reading, and ELA II were all assessed.
