RESOLUTION NO. 716
APPROVING THE SCHOOL TREASURER'S SURETY BOND

WHEREAS, Section 8-2 of the Illinois School Code (105 ILCS 5/8-2) requires that the school treasurer of United Township High School District 30, Rock Island County, Illinois, be properly bonded and that the bond shall be payable to the Board of Education; and

WHEREAS, Section 8-2 of the Illinois School Code provides that the penalty of the bond shall be 10% of the amount of all bonds, notes, mortgages, moneys and effects of which the treasurer is to have custody as measured on June 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, Section 8-2 of the Illinois School Code further provides that the bond shall be approved by at least a majority of the members of the Board of Education and filed with the Regional Superintendent of Schools; and

WHEREAS, the attached School Treasurer's Surety Bond #999188198 (the "Surety Bond") was executed by the authorized agent of The Ohio Casualty Insurance Company, as surety on or about May 27, 2026, and will take effect July 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Surety Bond will be executed under oath by Janice Roome as Principal before June 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the attached School Treasurer's Surety Bond #999188203 (the "Surety Bond") was executed by the authorized agent of The Ohio Casualty Insurance Company, as surety on or about May 27, 2026, and will take effect July 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Surety Bond will be executed under oath by Janice Roome as Principal before June 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the attached School Treasurer's Surety Bond #999261899 (the "Surety Bond") was executed by the authorized agent of The Ohio Casualty Insurance Company, as surety on or about May 27, 2026, and will take effect July 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Surety Bond will be executed under oath by Janice Roome as Principal before June 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education finds and determines that the attached Surety Bonds are in proper form and should be approved;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF UNITED TOWNSHIP HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT 30, ROCK ISLAND COUNTY, as follows:

1. The Board of Education adopts as findings of fact all of the recitals above and incorporates them herein by reference.
2. A majority of the members of this Board of Education hereby expressly approves the Surety Bonds as presented.
3. The Secretary of the Board of Education is hereby authorized and directed to file the school treasurer's bonds with the Regional Superintendent of Schools as required by law.
4. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption.
