The Board of Trustees approved contracting with Schneider Electric for an investment grade audit during the February 12, 2024 regular meeting. The Board has seen a presentation on the results and recommendations from the audit.

3. Process:

Due to the current financial situation of the district, the maintenance tax notes are the only option to finance the recommendations from Schneider Electric. The savings from the project Schneider Electric has proposed, will make the annual payments on the maintenance tax notes.

Capital One has provided the most advantageous rates for the financing.
