To whom it may concern:

Pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 to 11), I hereby request the following records:

- 1) Any and all district RFPs for a feasibility study to look at the viability of creating a K-12 unit district with Lincoln-Way North used as the high school and the proposal received from District Leadership Solutions in response to the district's RFP.
- 2) Copy of the contract with District Leadership Solutions to conduct a feasibility study on this subject.
- 3) Any and all communications, written or emailed, between District 161 administrators/board members and Lincoln-Way School District 210 regarding performing such a feasibility study, sharing the cost of the feasibility study and "purchasing" the Lincoln-Way North facility

I also request that, if appropriate, fees be waived as I believe this request is in the public interest. The requested documents will be processed by a representative of the news media/press and made public in the process of news gathering and not for commercial usage.

In the event that fees cannot be waived, I would be grateful if you would inform me of the total charges in advance of fulfilling my request. I would prefer the request filled electronically, by e-mail attachment if available or CD-ROM if not.
