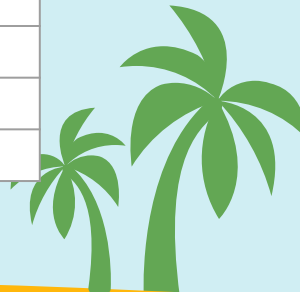
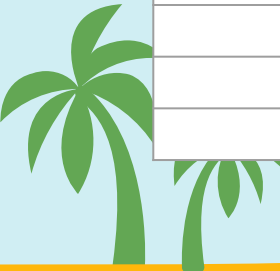

# High School Original Credit



Purpose: An opportunity for earning original credit, esp. for students new to Denton ISD.

<i>Model:</i>	Online, asynchronous w/ designated virtual teacher office hours
<i>Location(s):</i>	Asynchronous, no campus locations
<i>Instructional Focus:</i>	Course Options: (a) <b>World Languages:</b> Facilitated w/in the district (for incoming 12th grade students new to Denton ISD who have not completed state-required world language credits for graduation: Spanish I (2 semesters), Latin I (2 semesters), Latin II (2 semesters) (b) <b>Courses Needed for Graduation:</b> Facilitated via TXVSN, TTUISD, UT High School Courses: English I, II, III, IV, Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, Math Models, Biology, Chemistry, IPC, Physics, World Geography, World History, US History, Government, Economics, and some elective options

# Summer Dual Credit @ TWU

Purpose: To provide dual credit / original credit options for high school students

<i>Instructional Focus:</i>	<b>Course options:</b> ECO 1023 (Economics credit); HIST 1013 and HIST 1023 (both required to earn US History credit); POLS 2013 (Government credit)
<i>Students:</i>	Students eligible to the the corresponding HS course in the coming school year
<i>Fees:</i>	Students Pay Tuition and Fees
