Why Archery?

- Uptick in student and community interest (roughly 40 students, 6-11, attended an information meeting)
- Lifelong activity
- Diversifies our offerings
- Opportunity to get more students involved that otherwise wouldn't participate in anything in the winter

Impacts on Current Winter Athletics/Facilities

- Little to no impact to winter sports participation, as it will be on Sundays.
- Will need to work with Community Ed for the use of the North Gym during the winter seasons.

Structure of Archery Program

- Structure program as 6-12
- 1 Head Coaches
- 3 Assistant Coaches
- Season
 - December 1st- Mid-March
- Practices:
 - North Gym, Sundays

Costs of Adding Archery

- 1 Head Coaches @ 7.0% of BA+1 (**\$3,046.82 - \$3,924.27**)
- 3 Assistant Coaches @ 4.4% of BA+1 (**\$1,915.14 - \$2,466.68**)
- Annual Budget: \$500
 - After initial equipment cost, there will be limited additional yearly cost.
- Already have a \$5000 donation committed for the start up. There will be an additional donation yearly for equipment.

Approval

- Seeking approval for Archery to be added as an activity for the 2026-2027 school season.
