What are we DOING to accomplish our Turnaround?

Initiatives:

- Based on low performance in 8th grade Social Studies All teachers implement a US history lesson during Advisory twice per week. (Liberty Kids).
- Leading and Learning workshops to empower the teachers to take ownership of their learning by modeling new strategies and best practices. (Faculty Meetings/Team meetings/PLCs).
- All teachers attend at least 2 After the Bell Sessions monthly for professional development in addition to campus-based PD opportunities.
- Implementation of TEKS Resource System with fidelity.
- Efforts to improve culture by Ranger Shout-Outs, Spirit Sticks, and special recognitions.
- Over 500 annual walk-throughs including feedback for teachers.
- Spiraling of content via due now and exit tickets.
- PEG writing for 7th grade to develop effective writing skills.
- Stetson Co-Teach support.
- Learning Walks for all departments.
- Targeted Data-driven student intervention plans developed by each grade level and special programs.
- Campus-wide implementation of STRIDE Math for below grade level learners.
- Campus-wide implementation of IStation for Tiered Interventions in Reading.
- 1st-year teacher support provided by campus curriculum facilitators.
- District/Campus-based Peer Mentoring Network.
- Parent Tech Night to showcase available technology in ECISD.
- Off-site campus visits for professional learning.
