Proposal: Expand Pre-School Programs to schools in Eastern Section (380) of Denton ISD

Current programs:

Pre-Kindergarten Program (1/2 day program):

• This is state-mandated program that has been serving children who are <u>four</u> years of age on or before Sept. 1. It is currently offered at Paloma Creek Elementary School.

PPCD – Preschool Program for Children with Disabilities - (1/2 day program):

• PPCD is a special education program that serves children who have delays in the areas of speech, language, physical, social and/or emotional development. Now offered at Paloma Creek Elementary School and will continue at that school.



Pre-School Programs "Pilot" Program Recommendations for Cross Oaks, Paloma Creek

Pre-Kindergarten Program (½ day program):

•This is a state-mandated program that currently serves children who are <u>four</u> years of age on or before Sept. 1. It would be expanded to include <u>three</u> - and <u>four</u>- year-olds (as of Sept. 1) at Paloma Creek Elementary and would be started at Cross Oaks Elementary for both age groups.

Pre-School Academy for 3-year-olds/4-year-olds

- Children who are three or four years old on or before Sept. 1 are eligible to enroll in Denton ISD's "tuition-supported" Pre-School Academy.
- Students could attend ½ day or full day.
- Cross Oaks would offer two half-day programs and one full-day program, depending on availability and demand.
- Paloma Creek would offer half-day programs on a space-available basis.

Extended School Day for Pre-School students

• Children who are three or four years and attending may enroll in the Extended School Day program at the school from 3 to 6 p.m. for a set fee of \$165 per month (2011-11). ESD recommends a minimum of 10 students to pay for 2 instructors.



Pre-School Marketing Strategies

1. Purpose:

To recruit pre-school students and their families to Denton ISD pre-school programs.

2. Promotional Challenge:

Since the young children who will be attending the Pre-School programs, for only one year in most cases, the promotional & marketing programs must be ongoing from year to year.
