Campus Behavior Coordinator (CBC)	8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Allows other staff members to assist the CBC (EX: other AP or Campus Administrators)
Possession of Personal Communication Devices	14	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> HB 1481, signed into law by Governor Greg Abbott, mandates that all public and open-enrollment charter schools in Texas must implement policies prohibiting student use of personal communication devices during the school day.
Misuse of Technology Resources (AI)	15	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use AI in a way that would constitute academic dishonesty
Possession or Use of Nicotine Delivery Product or E-Cigarette	16-17	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> May be placed in DAEP or placed in ISS for a period of at least 10 days
Formal Teacher Removal	21-22	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Updated process for a teacher to initiate a formal removal of a student from their classroom
In School Suspension (ISS)	22-23	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No longer subject to any time limit (days) There shall be a review at least once every 10 days Student shall receive appropriate behavior support
Suspension Process	24	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In an informal conference with the CBC, the student will be informed of the alleged misconduct and have an opportunity to respond to the allegation before a suspension decision is made
Virtual Expulsion	37	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Circumstantial based on availability and the need of the student
Consideration of Virtual Education as Alternative to Expulsion	37	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Before an expulsion of a student, the District must consider alternatives.
