### **Preview of purpose and content of the report**

The District 97 Board of Education was asked to review the recommended Vital Signs of Student Learning for the 2018-19 school year during its August 14 regular meeting. The original intent was to bring the agenda item (*August 14, Item 3.2*) back to the Board for approval on September 4.

Following the August 14 BOE meeting, we moved the anticipated vote on the SY19 Desired Outcomes for Student Learning from September 4 until September 25. We used the additional time to schedule 1:1 or 2:1 meetings with any interested Board member in order to solicit feedback on the district's collective action plan for the 2018-2019 school year (click [here](#) to read the district's SY19 action plan).

### *What gets measured and reinforced, gets done!*

On September 25, we plan to request approval on the revised metrics outlined on the attached **vital signs scorecard** for the 2018-19 school year. Additionally, we plan to provide a sneak peak of the dashboard we plan to utilize this year to provide transparent, open communication with the community about the performance of the district as it relates to our **Vision97 4ALL** efforts (*click [here](#) to read the district's five-year vision plan*).

By approving the desired outcomes of student learning at the district-level, the board will enable school and district leaders to conduct evidence-based reflection of our work on a daily basis. It will also enable us to conduct "town hall" style conversations with our students, staff, families and community during which we can review, discuss, and perhaps adjust our measures based on the progress we will report on during sessions we plan to hold each trimester, Below are the scheduled dates for these sessions, which will take place at Julian Middle School from 4 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.
