Subject:	Board Policy – Criminal Records Checks/Fingerprinting – GCDA/GDDA (Second Reading)	
Background: The State Board of Education adopted Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 581-021-0502 which was created as a result of House Bill 2992 (2017). The impact of the new language requires the district, if it wants to fingerprint certain volunteer positions with direct, unsupervised contact with students, that those specific volunteer positions must be identified in board policy. The language proposed meets the OAR requirements.		
Proposal: Staff are presenting the policy edits from OSBA and are asking for the Board opinion to those positions that the Board desires to be impacted by this policy.		
Recommendation: Staff recommends approval of Policy GCDA/GDDA – Criminal Records Checks/Fingerprinting.
