Fortunately, an individual shared it with us via our system, and this morning members of the Oak Point Police Dept. are investigating.** Out of an abundance of caution, you may see an increased presence of law enforcement on campus today.

Please know that in these situations, we work carefully with local law enforcement to ensure accuracy, which does not always allow us to share specific details with our families.

We value the trust you place in us as we educate your student, and in that effort, we work daily to ensure your student feels safe on our campus.

If you or your student ever learn or receive information that would be helpful to us regarding the safety of our campus or one of our students, know that we have a system in place for reporting.

Students and parents can download the easy-to-use STOPit app which allows you to report safely and anonymously anything of concern to school officials – from cyberbullying to threats of violence or self-harm.
