For your child's protection and to minimize interruptions, please read this carefully ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE PROCEDURES

All children need to be signed out and released in the school office. Please do not go to the classroom to pick up your child.

Students riding buses other than their own, or getting off at a stop other that their regular stop must have a bus pass from the office

Bus passes, or passes issued for a change in a student's regular end of day plans will be issued *only after the office receives a written note* from their parent or guardian.

<u>IN AN EMERGENCY</u>, passes will be issued on request of the parent or guardian via telephone. *Billie is the only person* authorized to verify the identity of a caller and issue a pass.

NO CHANGES to after school plans will be accepted after 1:00 p.m.


Parents may request other adults to pick up their children if the school has on file written authorization and/or the name and address is listed on the information sheet as an emergency contact person.

When a child is going home with another student, <u>written notes must be received from BOTH students' parents.</u> This way we can confirm that both families know that a child is visiting.

Kindergarten students must have someone at the bus stop to meet them unless there is an older child with them on the bus. Otherwise, the bus driver will not let them off the bus.

In order to accommodate the bus schedule, and for the safety of our students, we ask that parents/guardians please DO NOT pull to the front of the school from 7:00 to 8:00 (9:00-10:00 on Late Start Fridays), and again from 1:00 to 2:30 p.m. every afternoon. Parents/Guardians should pull through the side gate and follow the drive around to the cafeteria where your student will be waiting for you.

2009/2010 ADVERSE WEATHER CONDITIONS





In the event of adverse weather conditions parents are advised to tune in to Radio Stations KRWQ, KAJO, KLDR, KBOY and TV Stations KOBI (5), KDRV (12), KTVL (10) or the 3 Rivers School District Web Page for information on school bus schedules.

Sometimes weather conditions leave some roads blocked or unsafe to travel but school is still being held. Under these circumstances "straight line routes" will be run. This is the information you will get on the web page or radio/TV stations.

When straight line routes are run the roads affected are listed below.

If you live on one of the roads the buses cannot travel, you may bring your student to the nearest intersection of the main road traveled. This will also be the stop for the afternoon drop off.
