• Mr. Viola, Mrs. Larson, and I met with LLCC administrators to discuss their dual credit offerings in order to expand our options for students. They have a proposal that would allow a student to have completed an Associates Degree by the time they graduate high school. There is a lot to be worked out, and some of our current offerings align with what students would need to take. One course we are looking at is the FYE (First Year Experience) that would be offered to 9th/10th grade students that are in Driver's Education as the corresponding course and we would replace Research. We have started the process of getting instructor approval through LLCC.

 - 11th grade ACT
 - 10th grade preACT/Secure10
 - 9th grade preACT/Secure 9
 - The ISA will no longer be given to 11th grade students. They will be tested for science on the ACT.
