SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of the quote from Whirlix in the amount of \$152,571.50 for the playground replacement project at Adkins Elementary.

BOARD GOAL:

Growth & Management – Demonstrate effective and efficient management of district resources

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Adkins ES needs an inclusive play structure to support accessibility for students with disabilities as well as younger students.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

Our Pre-K students are unable to safely play on our current play structures. The addition of turf will also ensure our students with mobility issues can access both the play structure and swings.

This playground equipment and installation will be purchased through a Texas Local Governmental Purchasing Cooperative (BuyBoard) contract. This purchase is being brought for approval in accordance with the District's CH (local) policy.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The cost will be borne through a grant provided by The Lantana Education Foundation.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

The approval of this purchase will provide needed playground structures for both students with disabilities and younger students.
