AGENDA ITEM: 2017-2018 Class Size Exception Waivers

ALIGNS TO BOARD GOAL(S):

<u>Goal #1:</u> Learning – The District shall provide an aligned, rigorous curriculum, preparing students to meet or exceed educational standards.

<u>Goal #4:</u> Human Resources – The District shall recruit, hire, train, and retain a highly qualified staff. <u>Goal #5:</u> Financial/Facility – The District shall exhibit excellence in financial and facility planning, management, and stewardship.

Background Information:

- Per Texas law, Kindergarten through Grade 4 are required to have a 22:1 student/teacher ratio.
- Approved in September 2017 for Stuard Elementary: 4 waivers, four of the five fourth grade classrooms required a waiver, each of the waiver classrooms has 23:1 or is 1 student over the maximum. Since this approval in September a Stuard 4th grade student has moved and we now only have 3 waivers at Stuard in 4th grade.
- December 2017 we are now in need of 3 additional waivers, all at Walsh. Both of the 3rd grade classrooms have 23 students (1 student over the required 22:1) and require a waiver. One of the three 4th grade classrooms is in need of a waiver, this class also has 23 students.

Administrative Considerations:

- In the 2016-2017 school year, the District received a Class Size Waiver for all elementary schools that involved a total of 25 classrooms. Each classroom with a waiver had 23 students or 1 student over the maximum. Coder had 7, McCall had 3, Stuard had 10, and Vandagriff had 5 classrooms that exceeded the 22:1.
- Additional elementary teachers (average salary = \$55,000) were added as follows:
