BOARD POLICY

1. The Board shall adopt a school calendar in accordance with the requirements of the Mississippi Department of Education and Mississippi law. The Board will establish. The official school calendar will be established no later than March of each year for the ensuing year and prior to the issuance of personnel contracts. for the ensuing school year.

The development of a school calendar involves consideration of numerous requirements associated with the regulatory responsibilities of the Mississippi Department of Education along with the Laws of the State of Mississippi.

For the purpose of long range planning, tentative calendars for future years may also be developed.

- 2. The school calendar will include the following dates:
- 2.1. Scheduled dates of attendance for students and staff members.
- 2.2. Holiday periods, including:
 - Labor Day
 - Thanksgiving
 - Christmas
 - New Year's
 - M. L. Martin Luther King Day
 - Good Friday
 - Memorial Day
- 2.3. Dates of term tests and semester examinations.
- 2.4. Issue dates for student report cards and progress reports.
- 2.5. Make-up days as a result of emergency school closings.
- 2.6. Any other information deemed relevant.

Input will be solicited from the community, students and staff regarding the development of the annual school calendar. Calendars will be consistent with existing state statues and regulations.

3. The Board authorizes the superintendent to develop and propose a school calendar consistent with this policy.

will be responsible for the development of a proposed school calendar to be recommended to the Board for approval and adoption.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE

A summary of those laws and regulations follows:

Laws of the State of Mississippi

1. The academic year shall be provides a minimum of 180 teaching days. (MS Code 37-13-63)

Beginning with the 1994-95 school year, no school district shall contract with any licensed personnel for less than less than 187 employment days. (MS Code 37-9-24)

Mississippi Department of Education Commission on School Accreditation

- 2. The opening date of the school year shall be is scheduled after August 1st and the closing date shall be on or before June 15th. (State Board Policy, AEA)
- 3. Two of the 180 teaching days may be 60% days provided that there are 198 minutes of actual instructional or testing and the remainder of each days is used for staff development or other related activities. (Standard 17.4, Bulletin 171)
- 4. Local considerations will be taken into account as follows:
- 4.1. Recommendation that The day prior to Thanksgiving Day be recognized as a holiday;
- 4.2. Recommendation that The first semester end prior to the Christmas Holidays;
- 4.3. Recommendation that The Christmas holidays extend over three consecutive weekends:
- 4.4. Recommendation that The school year be concluded prior to Memorial Day:

Recommendation that The following additional holidays be observed: Labor Day, Martin Luther King Day, and Good Friday;

- 4.5. Recommendation that Spring holidays include five consecutive working days; inclusive of two full weekends;
- 4.6. Recommendation that One staff day be provided for the purpose of Industry Education Day;
- 4.7. Recommendation that The Tupelo Public School District and Lee County School District school calendars be compatible due to such shared services as the Vocational Center and Alternative Schools;

Each semester should contain approximately ninety student days;

4.8. Recommendation that one full day be provided for staff at the end of the school year for the purpose of records, reports, and related activities;
