Goal 1 Review

- **Mathematics growth and achievement by 20 or more percentage points**
 - Use of Universal diagnostic math assessments K-12 to determine student achievement and growth. Provides data to determine gaps and growth rates over time
 - Additional targeted supports: Online pathways with teacher support, additional targeted staffing, tutoring for specific students
 - Math Curriculum review and adoption for 6th-12th grade-starting process
 - Professional development opportunities for math teachers

Goal 2 Review

- **Students, staff, and families will identify key conditions to create a physically, socially and emotionally safe school environment**
 - HS leadership project empathy interviews begin next week
 - Family engagement nights- Feb. 6th and Feb. 23rd
 - Conducted Student Health Survey in December
 - Staff engagement events this winter and spring
 - Equity team focus on specific conditions to improve safety
 - Provide recommendations to the board in spring of 2023

Goal 3 Review

Parkrose Student Board Representatives will work with Parkrose School District to create a support system for students who are impacted by racial incidents in our schools and at athletic events.

- Create a process for reporting and supporting Parkrose HS students
- Implement conflict and repair protocol with staff and students
- Work with OSAA to improve process for reporting and consequences
- Regional and state advocacy regarding implementation of new standards to address racial incidents in schools

Goal 4 Review

Parkrose School Board will focus on the following legislative, city and county priorities:

- Legislature: State School Fund advocacy based on COSA and OSBA recommendations, Workforce, Policy adjustments for PE, Facility investments
- City: Emergency response, Gun violence, Houseless response and support, Local zoning issue
- County: Houseless response and support, SUN programming

- Legislative Dinner in December
- Legislative Advocacy Day in February
- Legislative Advocacy during 2023 session
- Working with city and county on the issues we need to address
