Unity Updates Long-Range Plan

Unity School District's Comprehensive Long-Range Plan was reviewed and updated at the recent Board of Education planning session. The plan includes a strategic approach to the District's next ten years. The revised plan has various components; a Facilities Plan, Campus Maintenance Plan, District Vehicle Replacement Plan, District Teaching and Learning Pathway, Curriculum Development Materials Summary, Technology Plan Replacement Schedule, and Community Partnership Outline. A new aspect of the plan was included this year, a Curriculum Review Timeline that defines which curriculum content areas will be reviewed annually over the next ten years.

The Comprehensive Long-Range Plan will help to ensure that Unity School District continues to meet the needs of its students and community into the future, providing quality education programming. Unity is constantly evaluating programming to offer the best educational experiences for its students.

Student Open Enrollment Is Open for 2019-2020

What is Public School Open Enrollment?

Wisconsin's inter-district public school open enrollment program allows parents to apply for their children to attend a school district other than the one in which they live. Applications may be submitted to up to three nonresident school districts.

Who may participate in open enrollment?

Pupils in 5-year-old kindergarten to grade 12 may apply to participate in open enrollment.

Open enrollment for prekindergarten, four-year-old kindergarten and early childhood education is limited. Parents should call their resident school districts to find out if their preschool-aged children qualify for open enrollment.

How and when may parents apply?

The open enrollment application period for the 2019-20 school year is from February 4-April 30, 2019. The application period closes at 4:00 p.m. on April 30, 2019. Late applications will not be accepted for any reason.
