Continuous Improvement Team (CIT) and Professional Development

The COSSA Continuous Improvement Team met during our April 14th professional development day. Two sub-committees presented information and made recommendations for attendance and student growth. Pre/post test data was presented by Rebecca Owen and discussed by the continuous improvement team.

The attendance sub-committee presented an updated attendance policy that would include more proactive measures pending board approval:

- An attendance coordinator would be appointed for COSSA Academy and CRTEC
 - COSSA Academy Sam Pafille
 - o CRTEC Christina Barron
- School counselor to attend both Academy and CRTEC meetings to report at-risk students regarding chronic attendance issues.
- Mentors would be assigned to contact at-risk students.

- Home visits would be scheduled on a designated day each week via 'Community Outreach.'
- Communications would be sent by attendance coordinator to the home to notify and document measures taken.

CRTEC and Academy handbooks are being updated with the appropriate wording surrounding these initiatives. Teachers were given time to complete personal evaluations and to prepare for parent-teacher conference which saw more than usual attendance with generally positive feedback. Academy and CRTEC then met for recognition and desert/drinks at the COSSA Café.

The COSSA annual Career Fair was held on April 18th and met with good attendance and feedback with vendor positioned strategically by the supporting CRTEC programs. School counselor Gabby Nash, along with much support from COSSA administrative assistants Janie Willden and Christina Barron did an excellent job with preparation and implementation.
