

# **Annual Boiler Training for Minnesota School Districts**

### 8 Hour Lawful Boiler Operator Annual Training Requirement Course

This 8 hour course is designed especially for Minnesota school districts that want to meet their boiler operator annual training requirements required by Minnesota Statues 326B.974.

#### Minnesota Statute 326B.974 School Engineer, Subd. 2. School District Training States:

A school district shall allow to occur annually at least eight hours of training related to boiler operation to a licensee described in subdivision 1. The training must be administered by a licensed first or chief class engineer during the licensee's normal working hours. Two hours of the required training shall occur in the boiler room and must include demonstration of tasks associated with operating boilers. The tasks associated with operating boilers acceptable for the training must be from the list of approved tasks supplied by the chief boiler inspector.

#### Don't be caught out of compliance!

This class is taught by Ben Weekley who has operated boilers for over twenty years and holds a current Chief C Boiler Operators license. Ben has taught boiler operation classes to hundreds in our area in preparation for taking their Minnesota Boiler Examinations. During his years of boiler operation, Ben has been in charge of many different types of boilers including water tube, fire tube, hot water, steam, condensing, electric, fire box and scotch marine.

A minimum of two hours spent in the boiler room at Lincoln High School with hands-

on applications. Plus, Ben will be able to answer many of the questions that your operators are having trouble with or do not understand and give proven advice on safe and efficient operation techniques. All of the approved tasks as per the Chief Boiler Inspector will be covered. A "Mock" Specials Exam will be given so operators can test their skills.
