Motion to approve the meeting notes for September is approved.

Public Comment- Josh Musser would like to talk about why his children were pulled out of class the other day while in school, and made to work without being notified first. Nick Higson is supposed to be calling in any minute so we would like to table the discussion until Nick is present and can answer questions.

Nick Higson agrees and will make sure a permission slip comes home if ever there is an activity like this again.

Maggie Gore has a concern that some of the activities that the students could do to earn money are being given to people outside the community. to get all the wood stacked in the dry locked area so it doesn't get wet. This is not safe for the kids to do. Nick Higson assures Maggie Gore that Summer has a year to get her borrowed money paid back and he will make sure that there are opportunities for her to do so.

We are very excited to start a coed basketball team. Paul and Maggie Gore will be coaching. Thank you to you both for all your hard work.

Friday Activity- Friday activity is going well. There is volleyball and games. Dawn is doing good putting it all together. There is a large group of kids coming. Tutoring is going good. It has been nice having kids on Friday participating.

Treasures report- Our balance is \$4419.38. Was there a deposit done by Heidi? There is no slip yet. There is a \$260 deposit to be done on 9-5-17.

President's report- Ami would like to thank everyone for all the positive feedback and all the volunteers help.

Old Business- We still have not found a treadmill. We have \$500 approved if we can find one to purchase. Josh Musser will keep his eyes open in Thorne Bay.
