2017/2018 Completed Tournament Managers Report was given Golf and Cross Country Divisional tournaments. Both of these tournaments went very well. Athletes competed very well at the tournaments. There wasn't any issues that happened at either tournament. 2017/2018 Upcoming Tournament Managers Report

Volleyball Divisional hosted by Butte Central – report was given that Butte Central was prepared for the tournament and was excited to be hosting the tournament. Speech Tournament will be hosted by Ronan in January 2018, Divisional Wrestling tournament will be hosted by Columbia Falls in February on Friday February 2 and Saturday February 3. BBB and GBB Divisional Basketball tournament will hosted by Butte Central in February 2018. To qualify for the tournament, the Northwestern and Southwestern teams will have District Tournaments taking the top 4 teams from each District Tournament to the Divisional Tournament.
