

TITLE ONE

Williams Elementary is a Title 1 School. Title 1-A is the United States Government's largest educational assistance program for schools. Important School Information

Transportation Changes:

If your child will be going home with another student or you need to make a bus change, we need note from you. Notes must include student's full name, (first & last), date, and parent's signature. Please make sure all transportation notes are sent to the office. If you need to call to change your child's transportation plans for the day, the calls from parents only need to be made prior to <u>2:00 PM</u>.





Student Medication:

If your child needs to take medication at school it is a State Law that all medication to be taken at school is to be brought to school by an adult in the original container and kept in the office. A "Request for giving Medication Form" (available in the office) must be filled out by the parent along with the medication. Cough drops are included as a medication and must be in the original container.

Conference Days:

Parent teacher conferences are coming up. They are scheduled for Wednesday, Thursday and Friday November 3rd-5th. See Calendar for times. These will be in-person or by phone whichever is your preference.





School safety:

Please support our safety efforts by always using the front entrance when visiting the school. All visitors must WEAR A MASK when entering the building.

School start and end times:

School starts at 7:20am each morning. <u>PLEASE</u> <u>DO NOT DROP OFF YOUR STUDENT BEFORE</u> <u>7AM</u>. There is no supervision at that time. Breakfast is served in the classroom beginning at 7:10am. School is dismissed at 2:25pm. Students that are parent pick-up in K/1 and 4/5 are dismissed through the main entrance. Students that are parent pick-up and are in 2/3 are dismissed through the front entrance of the gymnasium.
