Teaching, Learning & Relevance

- Literacy and Numeracy The co-teaching model continues to be developed by the Math, ELA and Special Ed departments with a goal to begin instructional strategies at the start of the 2023-24 school year. Recent meetings have focused on structural barriers of time and staffing to determine the level of implementation that is feasible. Both of these barriers are being addressed with future work plans throughout Semester 2.
- Winter Fastbridge testing is completed and data is being reviewed with departments. The data
 will be reviewed for correlation with classroom assessments, teacher professional practice goals
 and student learning outcome goals identified in the vital signs. This will be shared in an
 upcoming scorecard update.
- PreACT assessment planning is underway to prepare for administration in April. This is the first time this assessment has been administered. This data point will be a numeracy and literacy achievement goal in future years of the strategic plan vital signs.
- The high school daily schedule is being modified in order to meet student life, career and college readiness needs. Examples include the incorporation of best instructional practices, additional opportunities for academic & career plan development, student support, and staff collaboration.
