Proposed Remote Learning Modification Recommendations

Remote Learning Strengths: Retain these elements in current plan

- 1. Instructional technology resources (hardware, support, online access)
- 2. Community support/collaboration (includes maintaining "sense of community")
- 3. Teacher collaboration (lesson planning, articulation, student supports)

Remote Learning Weaknesses: Improve these elements in current plan

- 1. Robustness of instructional model: need for increased synchronous learning, grading, differentiated assignments, introduction of new learning content
- 2. Consistency (including expectations for students, staff and families, course work, feedback/grading, frequency/usefulness of communications)
- 3. Consolidation and accessibility of technology and learning platforms across grades and courses (especially for assignments and communication)
- 4. Targeted programming supports (SEL, special education/related services, English Learning, Inclusive Pre-School and Kindergarten, and other unique elements)

Remote Learning Opportunities: *Institute these as new focus areas*

- 1. Strategies to heighten student engagement through enhanced interaction, intentional lesson design, increased student choice, and high interest activities.
- 2. Accountability elements for students to own and take responsibility for learning
- 3. Enhanced social-emotional supports for all members of school community
- 4. Coordinated communications framework and strategies that support staff collaboration and parent communication
