

CCC has grown from one employee and one client with 58 drivers (CDL) in 1994, to 15 employees and 646 client companies with over 20,000 participants in 2008.



Procedural Example for Uneventful Collection

- Day of testing, staff prepare restrooms in as unobtrusive an area as possible.
- Restrooms are inspected.
- Water access is restricted in restrooms. Blue dye is placed in the toilets and sinks are secured.
- Students are brought to screening area.
- Collector verifies laboratory name, address, and specimen ID number are printed on CCF and required number of copies are provided.
- Donor portion of CCF is completed by student.
- Collector reviews collection instructions with student and provides specimen container.
- Collector has student remove any unnecessary outer clothing (coats, sweaters, etc...) and leave any personal belongings (purses, backpacks, etc...) outside of restroom.
- Student is instructed to enter restroom and provide specimen.
- Student provides specimen in container to collector.
- Both student and collector are required to maintain visual contact with the specimen until tamper-evident seal is placed on container.
- Collector verifies that specimen temperature is between 90-100 degrees F
- Collector inspects specimen for unusual color or other signs of adulteration.
- Collector checks specimen to verify that sufficient volume has been provided
- Collector splits specimen into 2 containers.
- Collector affixes specimen bottle seals to the containers and asks student to initial the seals indicating that it is their specimen.
- Student is then excused while container and laboratory copies of CCF are sealed in specimen bag.
- Employer copy of CCF is provided to designated school representative.
- Collector either drops specimen directly with laboratory or ships specimens overnight to laboratory.
