We have some dollars to spend on summer school and will be looking at needed Chromebooks. Heidi Morris, MaKenzie Noga and Dave Delgado are planning to teach summer school. Erica Butler will be heading up the Freshmen Academy in August.

Our baseball team is ranked number 1 in the league and softball is fighting for a league playoff.

Scholarship night is Thursday, May 18th, we have a lot of seniors receiving scholarships. We will also have a Senior Class meeting on Wednesday, May 12 to go over senior activities and graduation and the activities around those June days.
