Agenda Item: Consider Approval of the Course ‘Musical Theater’ and ‘Show Choir’ as a Substitution for High School Physical Education Credits in Accordance with 19 TAC §74.12(b)(6)(B)
<p>Summary:</p> <p>The 19 TAC §74.12(b)(6)(B) states that in accordance with district policy, the required PE graduation credit may be earned through completion of any TEKS-based course that meets the requirement of 100 minutes of moderate or vigorous physical activity weekly and that is not being used to satisfy another specific graduation requirement.</p> <p>The substitution of a TEKS-based course has a Course Code of PES000015 (Sub Academic Elective) and may be used to note the completion of PE by other means.</p> <p>For your review, an explanation of this legislation is attached and may be found in Chapter 74, pages 8-9.</p> <p>Musical Theater and/or Show Choir are interactive courses wherein students sing and dance, build and climb, stretch, and move daily. It is recommended that Musical Theater and/or Show Choir be used to allow participating students to earn 1.0 physical education credit. This may be transcribed over the course of two years as determined by the district.</p>
