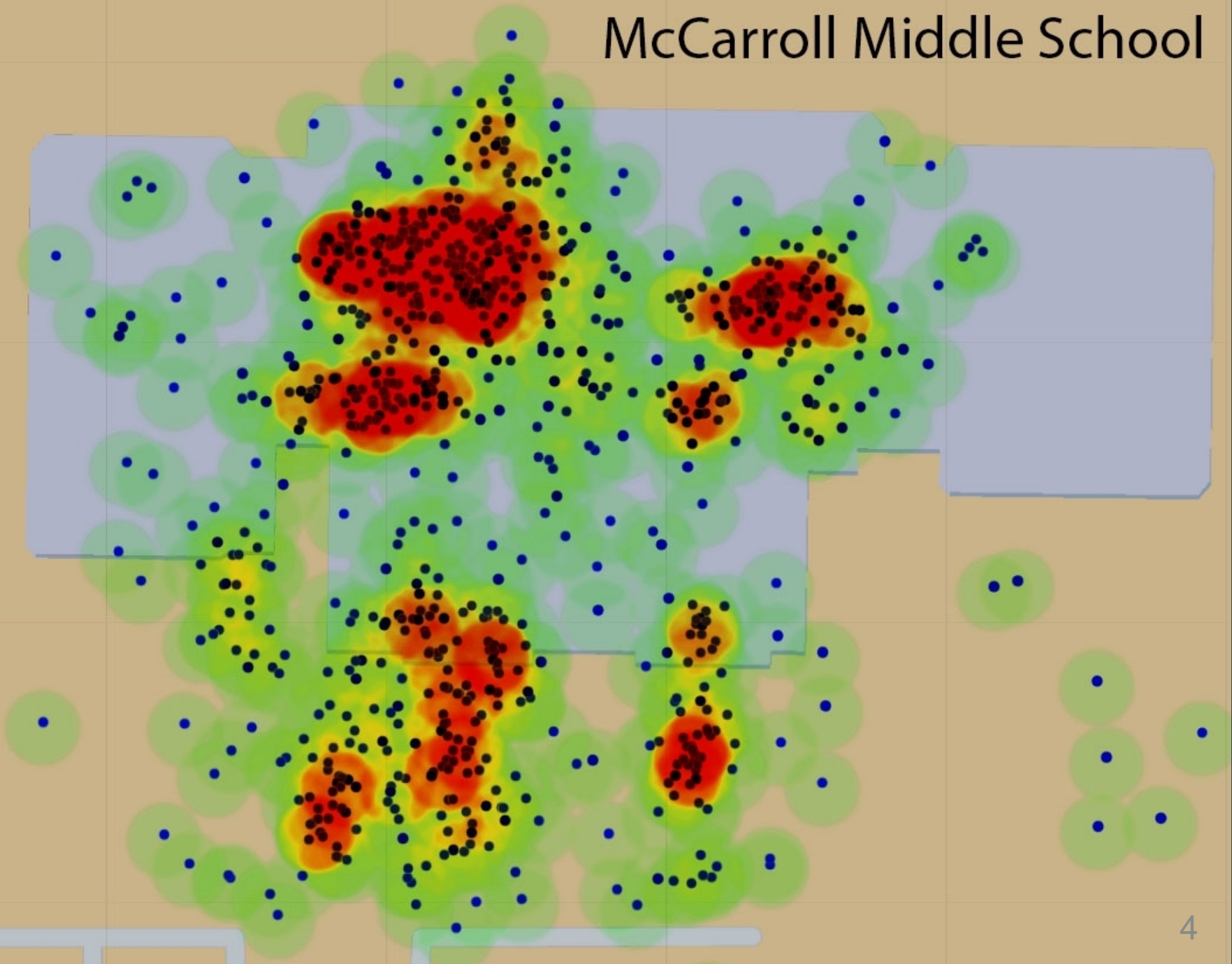

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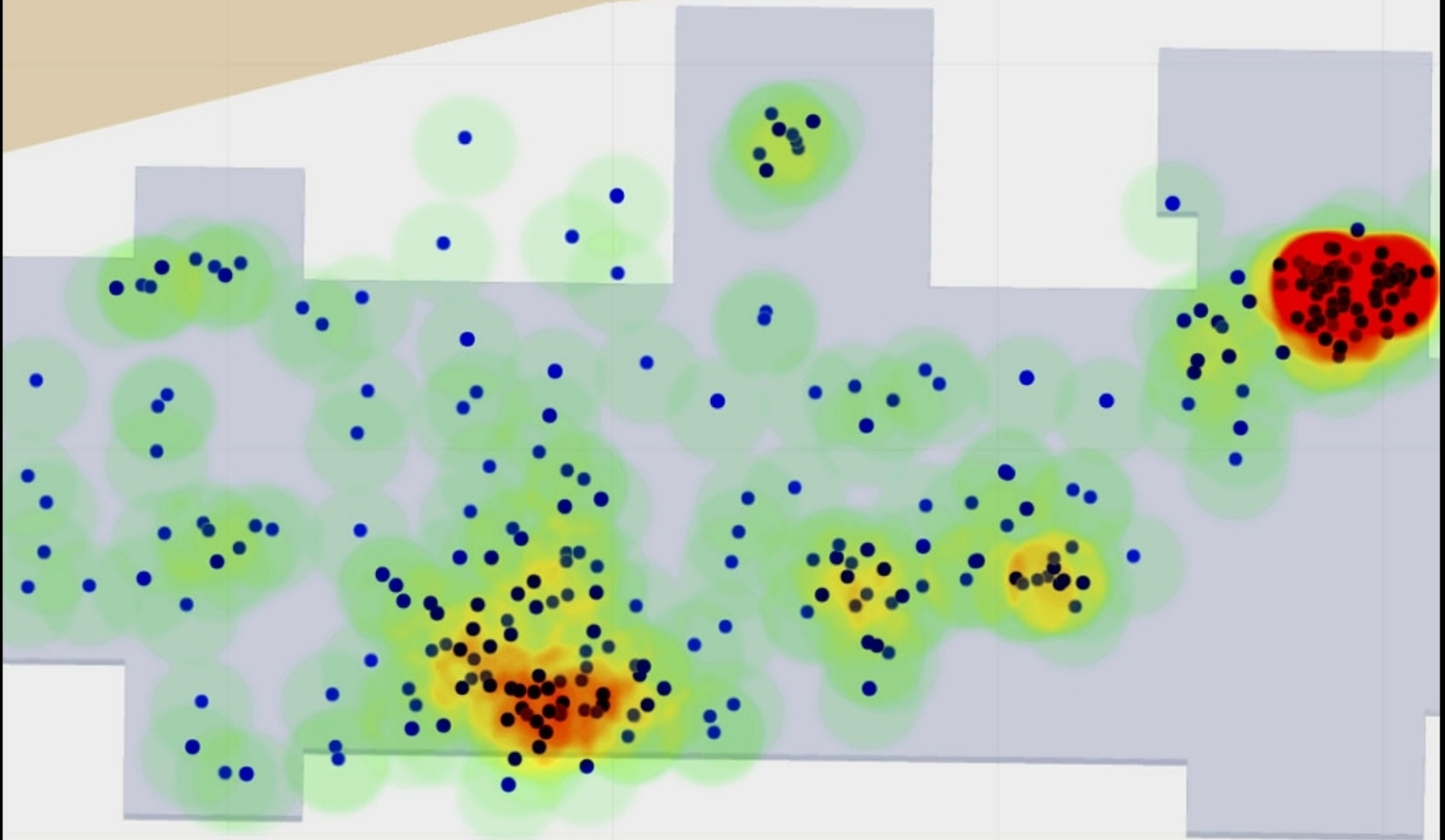

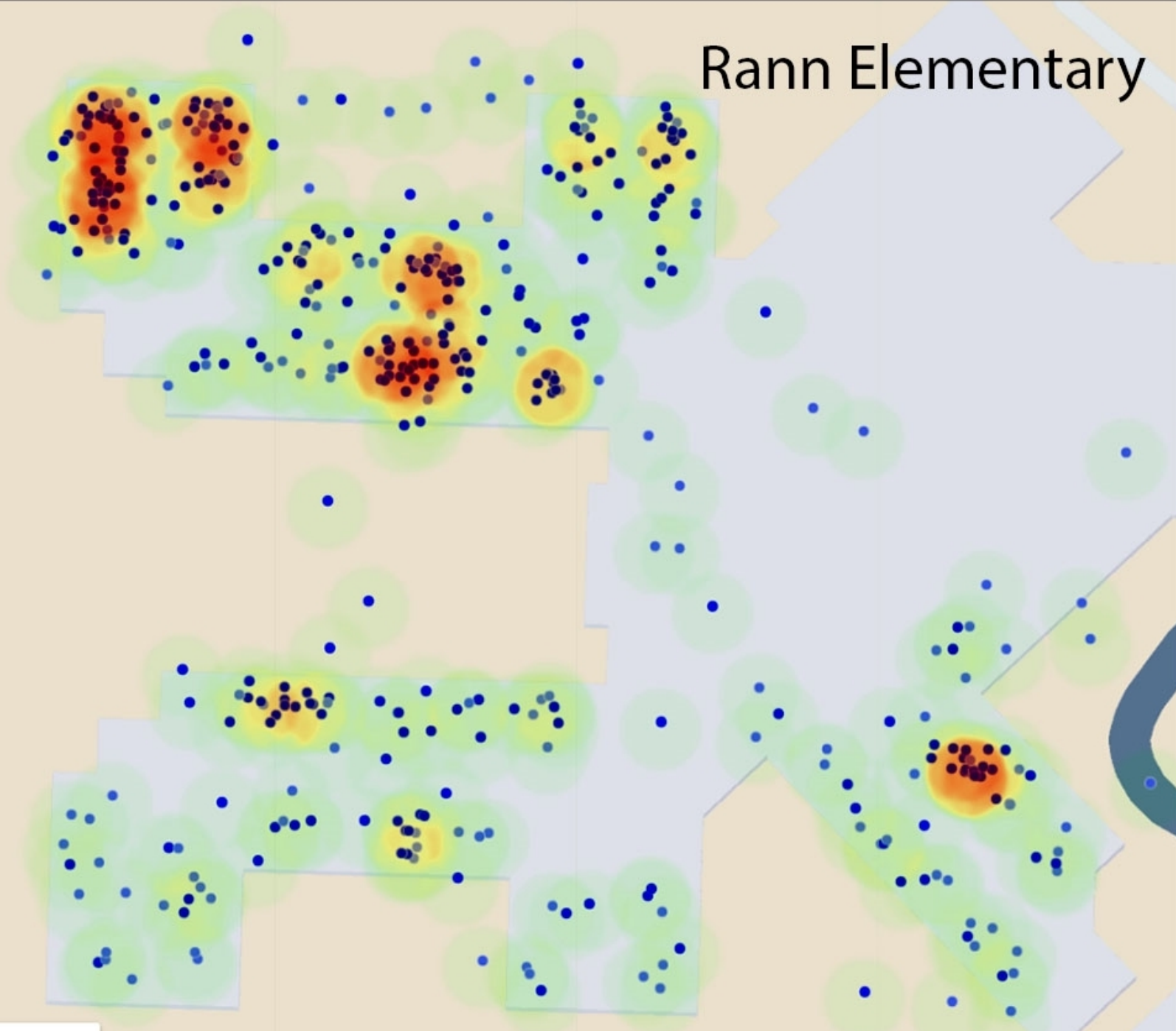

Content Filter 2: McCarroll Middle School

School Districts are required to be CIPA compliant to receive E-Rate funding. Students sign an AUP (Acceptable Use Policy) every year during enrollment. In addition, we provide students digital citizenship training throughout the school year. This training helps students learn what is acceptable and unacceptable when it comes to their behavior and interactions on the internet.



Content Filter

Students' activity is stored for multiple months to provide administrators and law enforcement the ability to investigate incidents that could occur. CIPA does not require the tracking of internet use by minors or adults.

- I am implementing a parent portal app for McCarroll Middle School. This app will allow parents to view what sites their child is accessing on school issued devices.
- A form will be available for individual parents of McCarroll to make requests for the remainder of the current school year. This will be fully available for all Decatur ISD parents in the 2025-2026 school year.

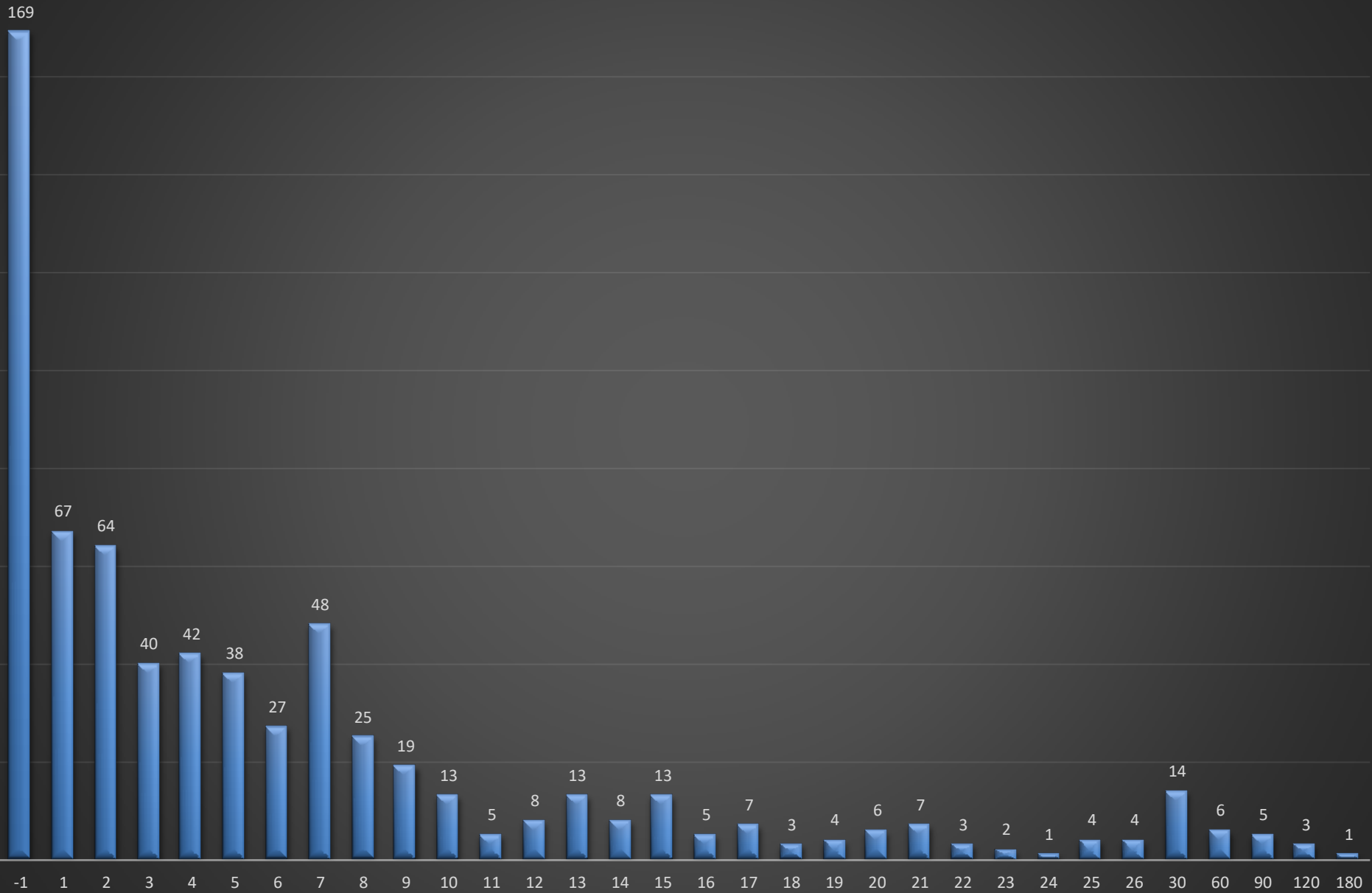

Accidents happen and damages can occur. These are the current counts on devices that have been damaged this school year:

- 128 MacBook Air's damaged between September 2024 and March 2025
- 9 Teacher MacBook devices have been damaged and sent in for repairs
- 113 Insured / non-insured Chromebooks have been damaged and sent in for repairs since the start of school
- 74 Elementary iPads have been damaged and sent in for repairs
