Read Act update

As part of the Read Act that was passed in the Legislature a year ago, schools need to screen students for characteristics of dyslexia or other reading struggles. At the high school we will be using what is called a "gated approach". This is a two step process where any student that was not proficient on their last MCA will be given the Star Assessment. This is the same assessment that FIS uses for screening. Any student that performs at the 20 percentile and lower will be assessed using the state required Capti ReadBasix. This is the only approved screener. The goal of this is to get the correct support to those students that are showing signs of struggling with reading.
