Title I

- Federally-funded, general education support program.
- Funding is based on the number of students who qualify for the free- and reduced-price lunch program. However, students do not have to participate in this lunch program to qualify for Title I services. Eligible students are failing or at risk of failing to meet grade-level standards. If all eligible students cannot be served, those most in need are served.

The goal

Title I provides extra help and instruction for those students struggling in reading.

- Student data is collected and submitted each year.
- Parent involvement is required
- Staffing at RWPS: 2 Title I teachers, 6 Title I Paras
- Approximate number of students served 2020-21: 240 students (K-4)
- Students are identified by our FastBridge Learning screening assessments; fall, winter, and spring. We also look
 at classroom performance, student grades, and teacher recommendations to identify students eligible to receive
 Title I services.
- Curriculum: new this year, Waseca Biomes
- Budget (2022): \$318,615.00* (2023): \$354,063.46

Current Curriculum

Waseca

- Based on 44 phonemes (sounds)
- The program uses a four-step approach in which the children spell the word depicted on the card with a moveable alphabet, a process that involves encoding or using the phonetic principle introduced to make a word. In the next step, the child lays out all of the cards and matches the label cards, thereby decoding the phonetic information. Additional practice in decoding involves writing the words and reading words that follow the same phonetic principle in a booklet.
- The sequence is consistent with that of the Orton-Gillingham Method in its application for children with dyslexia.
