



SCHOOL SUPPLIES ARE NORMALLY EXPENSIVE FOR FAMILIES.







Themes Based on Comments From Parents


- Equity and Inclusion The program ensures that all children have access to the same school supplies, preventing disparities based on financial status.
- Financial Relief Many families, especially those with multiple children, expressed that purchasing supplies was a significant financial burden. The program alleviates this cost.
- Stress Reduction Parents appreciate not having to search for specific supplies or brands, reducing back-to-school stress.
- Convenience and Time Savings The program eliminates the need for parents to shop, package, and prepare supplies, allowing them to focus on other priorities.
- ❖ Positive Impact on Students Children no longer worry about losing supplies or feeling different from peers based on what they have; shared supplies foster a sense of community.
- ❖ Long-Term Support and Expansion Many parents wish the program had existed earlier and hope it continues for future generations. Some even expressed willingness to pay more if necessary.
- Economic and Community Benefit The program supports families facing financial difficulties and contributes to a smoother start to the school year for all students.




Teachers Feedback (n = 75)

Which school do you teach at?




How did the number of school supplies you received compare with previous years (when students brought their own supplies)?



Themes Based on Comments From Teachers

- Financial Relief for Teachers Staff appreciate spending less of their own money on classroom and student supplies.
- Equity and Inclusion Ensuring all students receive the same supplies eliminates stigma and promotes fairness.
- Student Preparedness The program ensures that all students have the necessary supplies from day one, allowing them to focus on learning rather than worrying about missing materials.
- Appreciation for Effort Many acknowledged the hard work of those who organized the program and expressed gratitude for its implementation.

Suggestions From Teachers

- Ensuring Year-Round Supply Availability Teachers suggest including refills throughout the year.
- Earlier Delivery and Organization Time Having supplies delivered in the summer would allow teachers time to organize materials effectively before students arrive.
- Variety in Supplies Different colors for items like binders would help with organization and prevent confusion with identical materials.
- Grade-Specific Supply Lists Adjusting supplies to better fit grade-level needs would ensure students receive the most relevant materials for their learning.
- Support for New and Transferring Students Additional supplies should be ordered and set aside for students who join after the school year begins, ensuring they are equally prepared.

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
