To help address this tragedy they strongly support all of the mental health strategies implemented through the BISD Counseling and Guidance Department. Furthermore, they encourage parents to contact a school counselor if they suspect warning signs regarding their child's emotional state including:

depression

impulsivity

bullying

exposure to violence

acute loss or rejection

feelings of hopelessness or helplessness

family history of suicide attempts

aggressive or disruptive behavior

For each suicide approximately 135 people suffer intense grief or are otherwise affected. Please make time regularly to speak with your children about their thoughts and feelings. Reaching out to them could change the course of their lives.

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




